
**Giving Opportunity:**





## Crafting with Kids

### Puffy Paint Watermelon

You will need Barbasol shaving cream, elmer's glue, food coloring, black paint, a paintbrush and a piece of paper.

Start by mixing glue, shaving cream, and food coloring in a bowl. Mix equal parts of glue and shaving cream. Stir it until you get stiff peaks in it. You can always adjust the amounts! Once you have the perfect vibrant colors, start painting the inside of the watermelon! Then take the green puffy paint and go around the outside to make the rind. Grab a paintbrush and dip it in black paint. Put dots all over the watermelon to make the seeds and you're done! Note that when they dry the colors turn darker.

## Cooking with Kids

### Ham Pickle Wrap

Grab yourself:

- 1 jar of dill pickles
- 1 package of softened and divided cream cheese
- A pinch of garlic powder
- A pound of sliced honey cooked ham
- 6 inches of flour tortillas

For this ingredient mix the cream cheese with the garlic powder. Next spread the cream cheese across the tortilla. After that place a slice of ham over the cream cheese. Spread an additional cream cheese over the ham. Grab yourself a pickle and roll it up in the tortilla. Cover the roll up with maybe some plastic wrap and place the wraps in the refrigerator to chill. Remove the wraps after about an hour and slice the wraps. After slicing them into pieces lay the pieces on a flat tray or plate and then serve them to your friends or guest.
