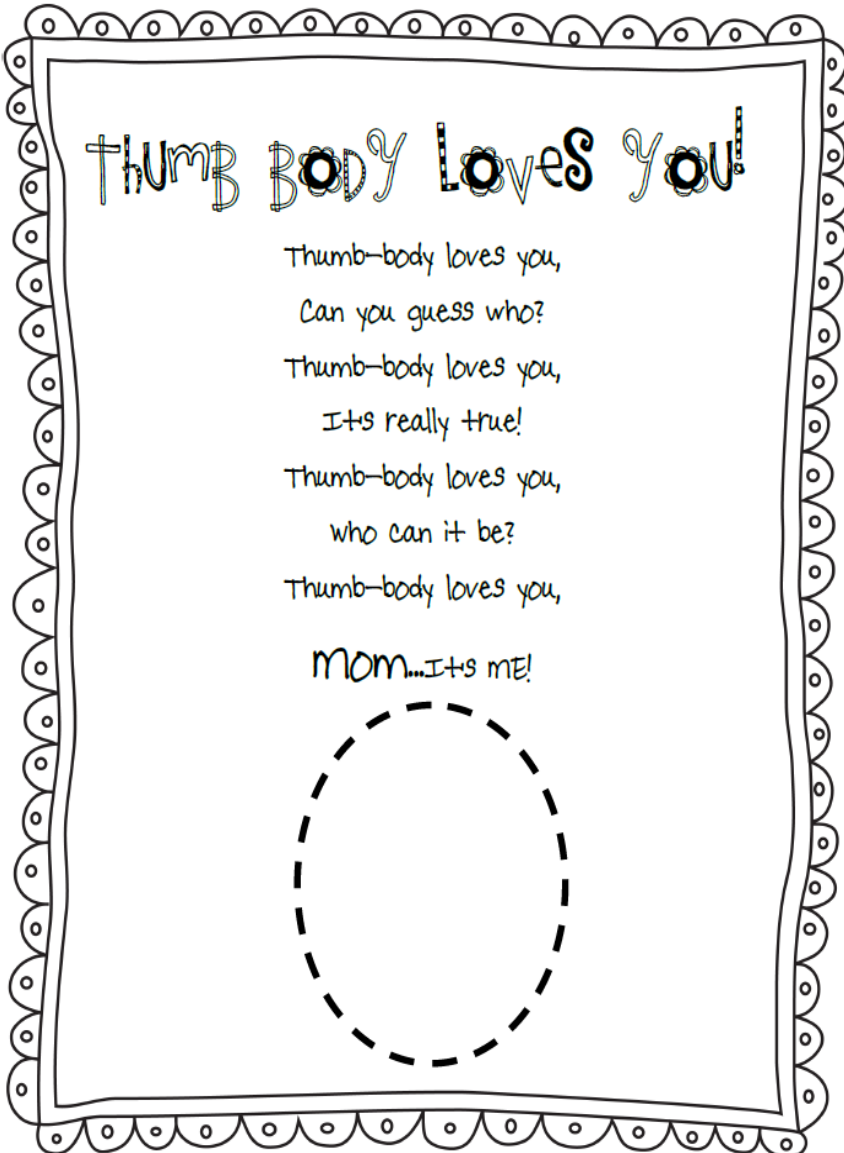


## Crafting with Kids
